May 14, 2013

The meeting of the McCook County Commission was called to order in their Meeting Room by Chairman Bill Smith. Members present: Ralph Dybdahl, Marc Dick, Sheldon Butzke and Ron Scharffenberg.

Chairman Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Smith called for approval of the Agenda. Auditor Sherman noted two additions: Tracy Hofer to present a plat and discuss personnel. Motion made by Butzke to approve the Agenda with additions noted. Second Dybdahl and motion carried.

The minutes from the April 16th, April 18th and April 23rd meetings were sent to Board members for review prior to publication. Chairman Smith called for approval of same. Motion made by Dick to approve these minutes for publication. Second Butzke and motion carried.

Commissioner Reports: Dybdahl attended the Southeast Enterprise Facilitation Project supper/meeting. Smith attended a Minnehaha County Regional Juvenile Detention meeting.

Mic Kreutzfeldt, Hwy Supt, informed the Board that the 2007 Sterling Truck engine replacement is complete and rebuilt transmission (\$3500) needed to be installed due to damage related to engine lock up. Kreutzfeldt presented an underground easement on behalf of Southeastern Electric. Motion made by Dick to authorize Chairman Smith to sign the Electric Line Right-of-Way Easement for Southeastern Electric Cooperative for the following real property: A Fifteen Foot (15') strip of land parallel and adjacent to the West and North property lines of Lots 2 & 3 of Murphy's Addition to Montrose, McCook County, South Dakota. Second made by Dybdahl and motion carried. Kreutzfeldt presented a utility permit for Southeastern Electric. Motion made by Dick to authorize Chairman Smith to sign an Electric Utility Permit for Southeastern Electric Cooperative. Scope of project: bore underground electric. Location of installation: 4 crossings on Fuller Ave in Montrose City. Second made by Dybdahl and motion carried. The insurance claim on Quonset building and contents was discussed and reviewed. The placement of a new Hwy Dept storage building was also discussed. Kreutzfeldt will present plans for review at May 28th meeting. The John Deere tractor and oil distributor are being repaired. Kreutzfeldt informed the Board that he will be attending a meeting later today regarding a Grade Raise Grant for 431st Ave at Lehrman Lake area.

Ron Bannwarth, Customer Account Technician/Butler Machinery, presented Lease-Purchase Agreement to the Board for a Caterpillar 140M2 AWD Motor Grader. Mic Kreutzfeldt, Hwy Supt, was present. The grader is being purchased off Spink County bid letting that was held on October 2, 2012. Purchase price \$258,240.00; \$100,000.00 down payment; and \$158,240.00 spread over 4 year lease period. Motion made by Dybdahl to authorize Chairman Smith to sign the Lease-Purchase Agreement. Second made by Dick and motion carried.

Motion made by Butzke to convene as Drainage Commission. Second made by Dybdahl and motion carried.

Mic Kreutzfeldt, Drainage Administrator, presented drainage permit applications, noting that downstream landowner signatures were obtained and he has signed off on them:

Brief discussion was held regarding Lake Thompson elevation. No action taken. The Board reconvened as Board of County Commissioners

Dwayne McIntyre, Custodian, and the Commissioners did take time to check progress of Courthouse building repairs.

Kathy Deters, Community Health Nurse, and Deb Haak, SD Dept of Health Region 6 Manager, met with the Commissioners. Haak reported that a new refrigerator/freezer will be coming and will have to be placed in the outer area of Nurse's Office and the State is also requesting that the County pay for a desk piece and installation of same; \$460.00 cost. The Board approved the request. Haak noted that a cherry wood table has been ordered for the office, with plans of this space being used by a nutrition counselor.

Auditor Sherman, Marian Oyen, Benefits Specialist, and the Commissioners discussed Care of Poor cases. A request for assistance was denied because the County didn't receive a Notice of Hospitalization. A Notice of Hospitalization was received from Avera St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen. An Application for County Assistance for a hospital claim was denied due to question of residency. Payments received for Court Appointed Attorney and Care of Poor liens were reviewed.

At 11:00 a.m. a Supplemental Budget hearing was held as advertised. No interested parties appeared for the hearing. Motion made by Dick, seconded by Scharffenberg, and carried, to approve and adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 2013-09

ADOPTION OF SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET for McCook County, South Dakota

WHEREAS, SDCL 7-21-22 provides that the Board of County Commissioners must make, approve, and adopt a supplemental budget providing therein for an appropriation for such purposes in such amount as the Board may deem necessary, and such budget shall set out in detail each item for which an appropriation is made and the amount thereof.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners did prepare a Supplemental Budget and cause same to be published by law, and

WHEREAS, due and legal notice has been given to the meeting of the Board of County Commissioners for the consideration of such Supplemental Budget,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that such Supplemental Budget be approved and adopted. The amount of the appropriation is \$100,000.00 to be distributed to the County Road & Bridge Fund in the Equipment line and the amount of the revenue is \$100,000 to be noted in the County Road & Bridge Fund under Sale of Surplus Property.

The Supplemental Budget so adopted is available for public inspection during normal business hours at the office of the County Auditor.

The Board reconvened as Board of County Commissioners.

In other business, Tracy Hofer, Dir of Equalization, informed the Commission that she will be advertising to hire an employee in her office.

Mike Fink, States Attorney, and Mark Norris, Sheriff, joined the meeting to discuss a court case involving juveniles and the cost of housing them. Fink noted that the Attorney General's Office is prosecuting this case, and it is out of his (the County's) hands. He will follow-up again.

The meeting adjourned subject to call.
